3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES.

Autonomous perioperative care of patients as well as assistance of the doctor during surgical procedures according to medical instructions

Key tasks:

- instrumentation in all surgical disciplines including preparation of the necessary instruments, devices and materials,
- performance of surgery-specific bearings and positioning,
- simple intrasurgical assistance,
- preparation and coordination of workflows to establish the operational capability of an operating theatre unit for the performance of surgical interventions (, non-sterile assistance),
- surgical documentation
- preoperative and postoperative transfer of patient data considering the necessary procedures, preparation,
- disinfection and sterilization processes and measures in the context of the medical device cycle.
- Competence in emergencies:
- · identification and assessment of emergencies and taking of appropriate measures

• autonomous implementation of life-saving emergency measures as long as a doctor is not available, in particular cardiac pressure massage and ventilation with simple ventilators, defibrillation with semi-automatic devices or devices in semi-automatic mode, as well as the administration of oxygen; the immediate notification of a doctor must be arranged.

Multi-professional cooperation:

Maintenance of continuity of treatment, particularly concerning:

- hygiene management,
- supply of preparations and explantates,
- participation in quality and risk management (e. g. surgical checklists, team timeout, WHO checklists),
- participation in the planning of the operation,
- · participation in the training and guidance of trainees,

• participation in the further development of procedures, standards, process optimization, medical devices, approval procedures.

Deployment in the emergency department and in the shock room, in endoscopy and in the processing unit for medical devices (AEMP) as part of the professional profile.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE ⁽³⁾

Employment with a legal entity of a hospital, a freelance doctor or a group medical practice, primary care unit

In accordance with the provisions of the Law on Temporary Employment of Workers (*Arbeitskräfteüberlassungsgesetz*), a professional practice in the field of surgical technical assistance is also allowed, subject to a quantitative limitation and the quality of the services provided.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Education and training at Schools for Medical Assistant Professions or Schools for Nursing or Specialised Training Courses on Surgical Nursing

Persons who are entitled to perform Operating Theatre Assistance may be admitted to the second year of education and training in Surgical Technical Assistance.

Additional information:

Access:

successful completion of the 10th school grade or an authorisation to perform Operatiing Theatre Assistance in accordance with the MABG, medical fitness, trustworthiness, knowledge of the German language

Duration of training:

3 years (4 600 hours)

Theoretical training: 1600 hours

Topics: Principles of professional surgical assistance, infection theory, hygiene and sterile supply, anatomy and (patho-)physiology, fundamentals of pharmacology and anaesthesia, principles of patient care and care in the OR and in endoscopy, medical devices, equipment and radiation protection, work processes and tasks in the OR and in endoscopy, surgical techniques including surgical specialties and special instruments, interventional and diagnostic endoscopy, emergency and acute management, quality and risk management

Practical training: 3000 hours

Mandatory fields of application: visceral surgery, traumatology or orthopaedics, gynecology or urology, Medical Device Processing Unit (AEMP), emergency ambulance / shock room, endoscopy, nursing internship on a ward of a surgical specialty, elective internship

Optional fields of application: further surgical fields **Principles of education and training**:

The trainees shall be encouraged to interact responsibly as part of their education and training. They shall be enabled to achieve the highest possible degree of openness, tolerance and acceptance of the diversity of people's sociocultural differences and to raise awareness of respect for the life, dignity and fundamental rights of every human being, irrespective of nationality, religion, colour, age, disability, gender, sexual orientation, language, political opinion or social affiliation. In particular, awareness-raising should be sought for those affected by physical or psychological violence, such as children, women, people with disabilities or other vulnerable groups.
