Therapeutic masseurs with specialised training in electrotherapy:

Autonomous application of electricity for therapeutic purposes, in particular through low-, medium- and high-frequency therapy, on a doctor's orders.

Clinical masseurs with specialised training in electrotherapy:

As an employee of

- hospitals or sanatoria

Therapeutic masseurs with specialised training in electrotherapy:

- as a self-employed person
