3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES.

- Performance of nursing measures ordered and supervised by nurses: applying basic nursing techniques; applying basic mobilisation techniques; personal hygiene and nutrition; patient observation; measures of preventive care; documentation of nursing measures taken; care, cleaning and disinfection of tools
- Co-operation in therapeutic and diagnostic tasks ordered in writing by a doctor and supervised by nurses or doctors: administering medicines; applying bandages and dressings; administering subcutaneous injections of anti-coagulants and insulin, including taking blood from capillaries for measuring the blood sugar level by means of test strips; tube feeding through an existing gastric tube; patient observation tasks required for medical reasons, e.g. measuring blood pressure, pulse rate, temperature, weight and excrements, and monitoring the patient's consciousness level and breathing; simple measures of thermotherapy and light therapy
- Including social care of patients and clients and performing household tasks

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE (3)

Particularly, hospitals, establishments that specialise in the prevention, diagnosis or treatment of diseases or in followup care, care of disabled persons, nursing of persons needing care or in collecting blood or blood components or that offer other health and social services; medical practitioners and home nursing services.

6. OFFICIALY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

- Training in a course for assistant nursing under the Pflegehilfe-Ausbildungsverordnung (Ordinance on Training in Assistant Nursing)
- Training for medical doctors in a short course for assistant nursing under the *Pflegehilfe-Ausbildungsverordnung* (Ordinance on Training in Auxiliary Nursing)
- Two years of training for nurses and final examination on assistant nursing

Additional information:

Entry requirements: Physical and mental fitness; trustworthiness; successful completion of nine school grades; admission test or interview. In agreement with the management of the assistant nursing course, the institution organising it decides on admission.

Duration of education: 1 year (1,600 hours)

Theoretical instruction: 800 hours

<u>Subjects</u>: ethics and nature of the profession; nursing; care of elderly people; palliative care; home nursing; hygiene and infectiology; nutrition, diets for patients with specific diseases or special needs; basic somatology and pathology; gerontology, geriatrics and gerontopsychiatry; basic pharmacology; first aid; organising leisure activities and motivating patients to participate in them; basic rehabilitation and mobilisation; professions and institutions in health care and social services, including operational management; introduction to psychology, sociology and socio-cultural aspects; communication and conflict resolution; legislation relevant for nursing

Practical training: 800 hours at specialised departments of a hospital, nursing care institutions and institutions offering home nursing, other health services or social services

Education objectives:

- Providing the qualifications required for taking over and performing all activities covered by the assistant nursing profession
- promoting a basic mindset respecting the life, dignity and fundamental rights of all human beings irrespective of their nationality, ethnic or social origin, race, age, sex, language, religion or political opinion, and responsible, autonomous and humane treatment of healthy, disabled, diseased and dying people
- providing knowledge and learning how to apply methods to maintain one's own health potential
- orientation of assistant nursing in line with a scientifically recognised theory of care in a field of activities under the supervision of nurses
- acquisition of the knowledge required for documentation
- contributions to assuring the quality of nursing care through creative work, communication and co-operation in personal, technical and other socially relevant fields
