3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

a) General knowledge and skills:

Comprehensive pedagogic-didactic instruction as prerequisite for the social-pedagogic profession; sound competencies and skills for dealing with social-pedagogic problems:

- the planning, implementation and evaluation of
 - educational and teaching work, oriented towards specific persons, ages and problems,
 - measures relating to intercultural learning,
 - special (subject-related) and general learning-support and learning-back up (i.e. planning of assistance measures as part of educational and teaching activity),
- the initiation of special assistance measures for children and youths with special needs and their integration
 cooperation with specialists in the field of therapeutic education (doctors, psychologists, therapists) and with representatives of other pedagogic institutions.
- counselling parents and custodians, cooperation with parents,
- working as part of a team, guiding of group-processes, effective communication strategies, advisory competence and conflict management.
- In addition: essential aspects of society and culture, as well as natural sciences, as a part of general educations.

b) Specific knowledge and skills:

- pedagogical, psychological and sociological competencies for educational and teaching work in the vocational field of social pedagogics,
- a sound knowledge of the subjects and methods in the field of creative arts (music, instrumental instructions, rhythm and music, art, crafts, physical education) for specific vocational application,
- road safety training for children and youth,
- knowledge of hygienic measures in day-nurseries, homes and other social pedagogic institutions as well as specific assistance measures in the field of health and home economics,
- initiating immediate first aid measures,
- knowledge of the vocationally relevant legal bases as well as the ability to draw up simple applications to courts and authorities,
- basic knowledge and skills in book-keeping.

c) Exceeding vocational competencies:

To communicate and cooperate effectively, to work as part of a team and lead teams, to develop one's own initiative, to act creatively and innovatively, to assume responsibility, to exercise a reflective approach to one's own and other people's behaviour, to communicate pedagogic views and attitudes to education.

Entrance requirement: completion of school year 8 plus aptitude test

Duration of training: 5 years

Duration of practical training:

approx. 504 hours on a single day basis plus a total of 9 weeks of placements, as specified in the curriculum, and 2 weeks compulsory workplace placement during the holidays

Training objectives

- in an integrated form, comprehensive general education and the vocational ethos, knowledge and skills required to undertake work relating to education and teaching in day nurseries, children homes, day homes for children and youths, as well as in school-external youth work

- access to the tertiary sector (dual qualification).
