## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

## a) General knowledge and skills:

Supplementary to the training as nursery school teachers, comprehensive knowledge and skills to specifically assist nursery-age children whose development has been subject to behavioural problems or developmentally disturbed or disabled nursery-age children, in integration work with individual children or within a group.

# b) Specific knowledge and skills

- familiarity with concepts and terminology relevant to therapeutic and special needs education as well as the scientific methods for recognising the relevant problem areas relating to disabled nursery-age children, assessing such problems and dealing with them, applying theory of action
- an extended insight into the fundamental principles of therapeutic and special needs education, focusing on aspects of psychology, sociology, biology and medicine, for implementing appropriate means of personal and social integration both within the family as well as in institutions (creches, nursery schools, special needs nursery schools, children's homes, clinics, counselling institutions, etc.)
- · cooperation within teams of co-participating specialists and working with parents
- knowledge of the special requirements for working in this vocational field, professional competence in assessing the sameness or diversity of didactic course of action to be taken in relation to various disabilities, underpinned by a sound methodological knowledge

## c) Vocational competencies relevant to other professions

to communicate and cooperate effectively, to work as part of a team and lead teams, to develop one's own initiative, to act creatively and innovatively, to assume responsibility, to exercise a reflective approach to one's own and other people's behaviour; and, from an aspect of basic humane values, to communicate pedagogic views and attitudes to education.

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE (1)

#### Pursuit of regulated professions on a self-employed basis (see also www.gewerbeordnung.at ):

Successful completion of the training course entitles certificate holders to pursue regulated as well as unregulated occupations in the field of special needs nursery school education and therapeutic care for infants.

Entry requirements: qualification as a nursery school teacher

Duration of education: 4 terms minimum

**Duration of compulsory work placement:** 240 hours on a single day basis in relation to the compulsory subject of "practical vocational training" plus 8 weeks of placements totalling 240 hours (to be completed while in training)

Education objectives: the vocational ethos, knowledge and skills required to undertake work relating to education and teaching of nursery-age children in special need of care (including therapeutic care for infants)

Subjects include: The subjects taught are listed on the school leaving (examination) certificate.
