- Knowledge of the requirements of social educational work in therapeutic and special needs institutions, of their methodical and didactic principles and therapeutic possibilities
- Ability to recognize professional tasks in therapeutic and special needs institutions and to deal with them in a competent, methodical and responsible manner

c) Vocational competencies relevant to other professions

To communicate and cooperate effectively, to work as part of a team and lead teams, to develop one's own initiative, to act creatively and innovatively, to assume responsibility, to exercise a reflective approach to one's own and other people's behaviour; and, from an aspect of basic humane values, to communicate pedagogic views and attitudes to education.
